Pregnancy

Pertensio may harm the development of the foetus. Therefore, you must not take Pertensio if you are pregnant and you must also not become pregnant while taking Pertensio.

Moreover, if you are suffering from pulmonary hypertension disease, the occurrence of a pregnancy can severely deteriorate the symptoms of your disease. If you suspect you may be pregnant, tell your doctor or gynaecologist.

Contraception

Birth control based on hormones - such as oral contraceptives or birth control pills, hormone injections, implants, or birth control skin patches do not reliably prevent pregnancy in women who are taking Pertensio. You need to use a barrier form of birth control - like a condom, diaphragm or vaginal sponge - in addition to any of these kinds of hormonal birth control. Be sure - to discuss any questions you may have with your doctor or your gynecologist - complete the details on the back of this card and take it to your doctor or gynaecologist at your next visit.

You should have a pregnancy test before initiation of Pertensio and every month during the treatment even if you think that you are not pregnant.
